After careful consideration, the Children’s Museum Inc. has updated our organization’s mask policy at all locations including at Roaring Brook Nature Center in Canton, CT. As of Monday, June 28th, when hiking and exploring along the trails or in other outdoor areas, if Nature Center staff feel that students are safely distanced from one another, masks may be removed. However, masks will continue to be required inside the Nature Center and will also be required outdoors when students are in close proximity to one another such as when looking at an animal during program time. Should you have questions about this change in our policy, please do not hesitate to contact us. If you choose to have your student keep their masks on, please have a conversation with them about this at home. We value the safety of your child, our visitors and our staff.
